

Portfolio web page assessment: Creating the solution

Assessed task:

You are to produce an e-portfolio with different sections or pages

A home page with sections:

- 1) A title
- 2) A short introduction about you (no personal details though – remember e-safety guidance!)
- 3) Links to at least three pieces your CT work
- 4) A suitable image

A second page or additional sections on

- 5) A hobby / activity / idea that interests [include an image]
- 6) Links to work from other subjects

NB: All the files should be in one folder otherwise the links will not work when you hand in!

Assessment criteria (maximum mark 8):

Achievement level	Level descriptor
1–2	You have created a page with some text about you and a suitable image or links to your work.
3–4	You have created a page with some text about you and a suitable image or links to at least 3 pieces of work. The page should be divided into sections (divs or table) For four marks there must be a good layout to the page or the work must be introduced with a sentence explaining when/why the work was created
5–6	There must be a good layout to the page. The work must be introduced with a sentence explaining when/why the work was created. There must be at least two sections or two pages with work from different subjects on the different pages/sections
7-8	The pages or sections work well together. There should be at least 5 pieces of CT and other work linked. There should be an additional section or page about a hobby/activity/additional skill that you do/have/are interested in.
