


Accessing RemoteApps by using a Mac

Use the following procedures to set up RemoteApps on a Mac.


1. Please download and install the Microsoft Remote Desktop App from the Mac App Store.




2. Open the app and click on Remote Resources.



3. The Remote Resources dialog box will appear.


4. In the URL section, please enter **<https://remote.hockerill.com/RdWeb/Feed>**
Enter your Username and Password in the following sections (Please enter the domain before your username, as shown below). Click Refresh.


5. Click Continue when the Verify Certificate dialog box appears.




6. The Remote Resources screen will appear again, this time with Successfully loaded Remote Resources below the Refresh button. Close the Remote Resources dialog box.

8. The RemoteApp Connection screen will appear. Untick Drive, Clipboard and Printers and click on Connect.



9. The app will open, ready to use.
