


# Accessing RemoteApps by using Windows 7 or 10

Use the following procedures to set up RemoteApps on a computer that is running Windows 7 or 10.

1. On a computer that is running Windows 7, click **Start**, and then click **Control Panel**.
2. In the search box, type **RemoteApp**, and then click **RemoteApp and Desktop Connections**.




3. Click **Set up a new connection with RemoteApp and Desktop Connections**.
4. In the **Email address or Connection URL** box, type your email address.




5. Click **Next**.


6. On the **Ready to set up the connection** page, click **Next**.




7. A Windows Security dialog box will appear on the Adding Connection Resources page. Please enter your Username and Password, tick Remember my credentials and click OK (Please put haec\ before your username).




- After the connection is successfully set up, note the name of the connection (for example, Contoso), and then click **Finish**.



- Close **RemoteApp and Desktop Connections**.



10. To access the connection, click **Start**, click **All Programs**, click **RemoteApp and Desktop Connections**, and then click on Hockerill Remote. The programs that are available as part of the connection are listed under the connection name.



11. Click the program that you want to use and click on Connect.
