- 1. William Shakespeare was a playwriter, actor and poet, who was born in Stratford-Upon-Avon in 1564.
- 2. There were four genres of plays he wrote tragedies, comedies, romances and histories. 'Romeo and Juliet' is a tragedy, 'Much Ado About Nothing' is a comedy. 'Richard III' is a history and 'Pericles, Prince of Tyre' is a romance.
- 3. He married Anne Hathaway when he was 18, and had three children, Susannah, Hamnet and Judith.
- 4. He died on the 23rd April 1616, in Stratford-Upon-Avon.
- 5. Shakespeare's first play was 'Henry VI', and his last play was 'The Two Noble Kinsmen'.
- 6. When the theatres closed because of a plague, Shakespeare wrote poems, such as the 'Sonnets'.
- 7. The Globe Theatre was built in 1599, but burnt in a fire in 1613. A second was built in 1614, but closed in 1642. A modern one was built in 1997.
- 8. Shakespeare died on the same day he was born, 23rd April.
- 9. He is considered as the best British writer of all-time.
- 10. His most famous include 'Romeo and Juliet', 'Hamlet', 'Macbeth'.
