

Project 2:



Page 9: Evaluation

In my Chiacehere practical, I was successful in meeting the main criteria/ quality control points that I had set myself and fulfilling the aim of the practical which was to produce a batch of Chiacehere in time that were more or less of a consistent size and shape.

During the practical, I used the correct techniques in the shaping processes. I followed the recipe throughout but some amendments were needed: I had to change the time in on the oven from S minutes to 4 because they were a bit burnt on 5 minutes. My Chiacchere were all fairly similar size, shape and thickness however, If I were to repost this practical, I would ensure that I had a roller with ta zigzag edge to add more texture to the Chiacchere.

Having produced the Chiacchere, I believe I have been able to meet all relevant criteria points and quality control points including:

In terms of nutrition, chiacchere are renowned for being high in sugars so they are considered a treat or a special oceasion food rather than an everyday snach, but the sail and sugar levels are acceptable. For the parazerotti, I would try to use less filling because some of them overflowed; I would also try to roll out the dough thinner because it was too thick for me. For my pizza, I could have maybe used more sauce, but other than that, I think it was my best one, almost no mistakes.


